Father Joe's Villages

Father Joe's Villages mission is "to prevent and end homelessness, one person at a time", with their core values of Compassion, Respect, Empathy, Empowerment, and Dignity acting as the foundation for their work.

Father Joe's Villages started at a small chapel in downtown San Diego in 1950. It was started to serve San Diegans experiencing homelessness and poverty, and in the past 75 years, has grown to include a comprehensive campus and scattered-site programs that house over 2,000 people nightly. They provide a wide range of programs--including housing, employment training, childcare, and medical, dental, and mental health services.



Our History with Father Joe's Villages

The Salvador Foundation began working with Father Joe's Villages in 2025, working together to create a "Welcome Home" kit program.

These kits are for individuals and families in San Diego who are transitioning into permanent housing.

Each kit is packed in a laundry basket and includes new-home essentials like pots and pans, dish towels, dinnerware, bathroom essentials, and more.

Last year, with the help of Father Joe's employees and some amazing volunteers, the Salvador Foundation team assembled 100 "Welcome Home" kits.

So far in 2026, we have assembled 100 kits, and we are committed to assembling another 100 by the end of this year.
