Our History with Camp Firefly

The Salvador Foundation began working with Hearts in Action as a non-operating foundation in 2010 and switched to an operating agreement in 2018.

Over the past 14 years, some of our involvement includes:

- Assist in administering the one-week camp; collaborate with designing positive experiential programs, counseling programs, and activities
- Two Salvador Foundation board members participate as counselors at the camp each year
 - Chaperoning family to acquaint them with their cottage and camp facilities
 - Assisting campers during all activities including transportation needs and attending meals
 - Daily staff meetings to discuss any specific needs (emotional or physical) of each camper
 - Watching children as needed to give parents a chance to relax and connect with each other
